Physical fitness is developed through outdoor activities. Knowledge is gained through learning about leadership, culture, and a strong emphasis on meeting the needs of "others". Children learn to make such traits as an integral part of their lives through a number of "others-oriented" activities.

Keepers of the Faith Clubs permit every child to achieve without competing against each other. Success is not dependent on brains, talent or speed. Hard work, character and perseverance are the requirements for achievement in this ministry, as in life.

Keepers of the Faith Clubs promote parent-child relationships, family, and God's design for a feminine woman. We have a mission from God to teach our children. Let us minister together to train them up to be strong, godly adults who are independent of the world, and yet fully dependent on God.
